

John Donne Society 33rd Annual Conference
(University of Lausanne, 27-30 June 2018)

Registration:

All participants and attendees must register for the conference. **Registration and payment will be by credit card through an online form.** We will let you know as soon as the form is available. The registration fee includes the conference dinner on Saturday night. Accompanying persons are welcome to join for dinner and can also be registered on the online form.

Conference fee (regular; includes closing dinner):	135.- CHF
Conference fee (graduate student; includes closing dinner):	60.- CHF
Lunch (Thursday-Saturday)	20.- CHF / day
Closing dinner for accompanying person:	75.- CHF

Accommodation:

Conference participants are asked to make independent arrangements for accommodation. Below is a list of hotels within easy reach of the conference venue and that can guarantee conference room rates (prices in CHF below). Single and double rooms are pre-booked for the conference **until 14 April 2018**. Please **mention the John Donne Society 2018 Conference when booking** in order to obtain the conference rate. Since hotels in Lausanne tend to be small and can fill up quickly, it is advisable to book early. (These are the lowest conference rate prices in these hotels. Lake view rooms, where available, will cost a bit more, but there is still a conference discount.)

Directions to Lausanne

All these hotels are close to Lausanne train station. For participants arriving at Geneva Airport, regular trains to Lausanne train station can take you there in about 50 minutes. **Make sure that you get a one-way ticket (28 CHF)**, as return tickets are only valid for 24 hours.

Directions to the conference room (“Anthropole” building, room 2055)

The conference will take place on the campus of the University of Lausanne, in room 2055 of the “Anthropole” building. The metro stop is “UNIL-Chamberonne” on the M1 line. To reach the campus from the train station and the hotels AuLac, Elite, Alagare and Alpha Palmier, you can take the metro “M2” to the stop “Lausanne-Flon”, and change to the “M1” metro line to the stop “UNIL-Chamberonne”.

From the Bellerive hotel, you can take the bus n°25 to the stop “Bourdonnette” and then take the “M1” metro line (heading towards “Renens-Gare”) for one stop until “UNIL-Chamberonne”.

All the conference sessions will be held in room 2055 of the building “Anthropole”. To get there from the “UNIL-Chamberonne” metro stop when arriving from Lausanne, turn right as you head of the metro, cross the tracks and take a left. Turn at the next right, and head into the Anthropole building that is in front of you. Head straight until you find yourself below concrete staircases: the 2055 conference room will be on your right. Please refer to the first map on the next page.

Meals:

Upon registration, you will be asked to sign up and pay for lunch coupons worth 20.- CHF. Tables will be reserved for our group at the main Cafeteria on campus, in the Unithèque building. It offers a wide range of catered hot meals, sandwiches, salads, pizzas, burgers etc.

There are no arrangements for dinner together (except on Saturday night) but optional outings will be organized every night.
